

What's for Breakfast in Wayne Schools?



Who needs to get their day started off right? We all do, by eating a well balanced breakfast each day. Get our minds and body, off and running every morning.

Wayne Schools' Foodservice Program offers **breakfast daily** in the *Elementary school* cafeterias from **8:30 am to 8:55 am.** & from **7:30 am to 7:55 am** in the *Middle school* cafeterias.

What can I get for breakfast?

We offer a wide variety of options daily like fresh fruit, whole grain cereal, muffins, 100% fruit juice, scrambled eggs, pancakes, waffles, omelets, French toast, breakfast wraps and pastries are some of the choices we have offered.

Each breakfast must have three of the following four components.
(Fruit, Milk, Bread/ Grain and/or Meat/ Meat alternative)

How much does this cost?

As part of the National School Lunch Program, breakfast only costs **\$1.50 Elementary and \$1.55 Middle** for **Full Paid Students**, **\$.30** for **Reduced Paid Students** and is **free** for the **Free Students**.

Adult Breakfast meals cost \$2.05

Breakfast meals are paid the same way as lunch, either by cash, check or account/on-line. Check the foodservice section of the district website for more details on payment options.

The *High Schools* offer a branded concept- *Jazzman's*, which has a la carte (sold separately) breakfast items. *Jazzman's* is a coffee shop that offers fresh bagels, homemade breakfast pastries, scones, parfaits, hot and cold beverages. *Jazzman's* is open before school from **6:30- 7:20 am & open throughout the school day until 12:40pm.**
