

Wayne Public High School Free/ Reduced Lunch Program

Frequently Asked Questions-

How much can I spend?

-Free students can receive up to \$3.15 of lunch items and Reduced students can purchase up to \$3.15 of lunch items and pay .40 cents.

What can I get for that?

-Any lunch entrée that costs \$3.15 or less with fruit or vegetable side dish and a milk, juice cup or fountain beverage.

What if I want to spend more than that or want a packaged beverage?

-You are responsible to pay the difference after the above daily limit of \$3.15 and pay for any packaged goods including bottled beverages.

Can I purchase snack items as a lunch?

-No, the benefit provided by Wayne Public Schools is for a lunch entrée items only.

Can I purchase a bagel for a lunch?

-Yes, you can have a bagel as a free/ reduced lunch and we encourage everyone to take well balanced lunch which includes a fruit and/or vegetable side dishes.

What if I do not have the money to pay?

-You can use your account number to charge, knowing that you are responsible to pay it back the next day. Please refer to the District Charge Policy.

Are there Menu items offered above the \$3.15 limit at no extra charge ?

-Yes, all Meal Deals, Hot Picks #1 (listed first on the high school price list), Salad Expressables and each include a choice of milk, juice cup or fountain beverage.

How can someone get Free or Reduced Lunches in High School?

-The same way it is done in the elementary and middle schools, by getting an application from the nurse and having it completed and submitted back to the nurse for approval.
